

Protect All Fiberglass Oxidation Remover & Color Restorer

We know from looking at some of the bikes in our 100,000-Mile Club that at least a few Harleys out there get ridden hard and put away wet. Years of riding in all kinds of weather can take its toll on just about anything. Even rocks weather away eventually, so what do you think happens to delicate paint?

Recently, Protect All, Incorporated introduced a new product designed to delay, and even reverse, some of the outward symptoms of the aging process on painted and fiberglass finishes (not for people, unfortunately). It's a moderately abrasive liquid polish and wax formulated specifically to remove light to medium oxidation and restore color and shine to dull enamel, polyurethane-painted aluminum, gelcoat and fiberglass. The cleaners and abrasives also allow it to remove hard-water spots, wax build-up, bug stains and surface scratches. It is not recommended for soft clear-coat finishes.

A dull appearance is usually caused by oxidation from the sun's damaging ultraviolet rays. In order to achieve a lasting, high-gloss shine on an oxidized finish, it's necessary to remove at least part of the oxidized portion and expose a clean layer of paint or fiberglass. Although we didn't have any oxidized bikes to try the stuff out on, we did have a staffer's cage that looked like a poster car for oxidation to try it on, and our **American Rider** trailer was similarly faded from years of outdoor storage in the California sun.

A few minutes spent applying the product left us very impressed. The results were stunning; with just a soft cloth and a little "elbow grease," the finish on the car was quickly restored to a near-new appearance. On large or heavily oxidized surfaces, the use of a power buffer will make the job go easier. This was the case with the fiberglass motorcycle trailer, which required buffing because it was bleached from its original black to medium gray.

Professional paint jobs can be quite expensive, original paint is only original once, and a lot of owners want to keep their rides the way they left the factory as long as possible. We found Protect All's Fiberglass Oxidation Remover & Color Restorer to be an effective product that can help postpone the trouble and expense of refinishing.

Some oxidized surfaces, left untreated, may be irreparably faded, requiring professional refinishing. If, under these circumstances, the Protect All Oxidation Remover and Color Re-storer doesn't perform to your satisfaction, return it to Protect All with the sales receipt for a full refund.
