

Protect All

Instant clean-up and protection.

When *American Rider* staff members are out on the road on a photo session, we need something to help clean and polish our Harley photo subjects before the lensman exposes the film. It's not convenient to haul cleaners, polishes and waxes in already limited luggage space, so we usually pack a small six-ounce aerosol can of Protect All.

Ideally, Protect All is best used on freshly washed surfaces, but the product is formulated to be a non-abrasive cleaner and wax, and we've found it useful even under less-than-perfect conditions. Whether out in Death Valley, California, or in the pits at Road America, Wisconsin, just spray it on, wipe dry without hard rubbing, and the bike shines.

It also repels dirt. We've found that when used on a regular basis, surfaces wipe clean in a jiffy. And if water is available, a quick rinse releases the bugs and grime without scraping and scrubbing. The product also contains an ultraviolet light block.

Back at the offices, we keep non-aerosol 16-ounce trigger-pump bottles around. After washing the bike, a quick squirt of Protect All on windscreens, chrome, aluminum, rubber, vinyl and painted surfaces, and a quick rub-down cleans and polishes. It's quick and it leaves a protective shine that causes rainwater to bead up and roll off—spray on, wipe off. Done.
