Super Product Has Uses You Haven't Even Dreamed Of Yet!

Dirt, grime, bugs, smog, oil, grease, fog and irritable seagulls with A-6 complexes are in league to make my airplane look like it's visited first thing every morning by the dirty aircraft fairy.

They're also after my car, my motorcycles, and, for all I know, my kids.

During the past two years, there has been one product that has consistently and reliably been fighting off these airborne villains. It's inside an unassuming little blue can with white lettering and the title says it all:

Protect All.

We first tested it a couple of years ago, along with some other miracle cleaners, and proclaimed it the ideal product. Simple to use, fast-acting, effective and better than the manufacturer's claims.

We have no idea what's in it, other than some petroleum derivative. All we can be sure of is that when you follow the directions (spray on lightly and wipe off with a clean cloth) you get a slick, clean surface, no matter whether it's metal, glass, fiberglass, Kevlar, plastic or composites.

It's also great for lubricating locks, cleaning instrument panels, flushing gas stains from wheel pants (admittedly not its forte) and probably half a dozen things we haven't discovered yet.

The guy who makes this stuff, Adam Huber, is the world's most enthusiastic proponent, as well he should be. But it was a little hard at first to take his success stories from customers as valid until we tried it ourselves.

There are two things we keep in the airplane we'd never leave the ground without, one is the Pilot's Guide to California Airports and the other is Protect All. It's that good and if you visit our hangar or garage, you'll see cases of it sitting about.

Huber's company has also come out with a new product for cleaning really dirty vehicles called "Quick and Easy Wash." He says it will save water because there is "no rinsing," just add it to your wash water and it will clean just about anything and certainly any vehicle.

As does Protect All, which also saves a lot of water since you can spray it on a dirty airplane, car or motorcycle-or boats-and it cleans while protecting.

At this writing, we haven't had the time to test the Quick & Easy Wash but if it works only half as well as Protect All, it's probably twice as good as the next best thing. And if you are one of those cynical people who think this review is somehow tied to advertising, all we can say is that we lost three clients this past year by writing negative reviews of their products.

This is really good stuff.
